In the wake of a devastating fire blaze in Sungai Aur Village, Kumpeh District, Muaro Jambi Regency, Indonesia, on 14 March 2021, Mewah Group has swiftly assembled a team to provide disaster relief to communities in need.

Staffs from PT Jambi Batanghari Plantations (PT JBP) volunteered their name and effort for the relief exercise to rebuild homes for residents in Sungai Aur Village who have lost their homes in fire.
