The program was kick-started with some exciting icebreaker activities to help everyone start getting to know each other, start collaborating and engaging with speakers.

Some key *take-home messages* are topics related to human rights, personal safety, home safety, and road safety.

In addition, the volunteered firefighting team was demonstrating the knowing-how to use a fire extinguisher and other invaluable live saving skills that everyone should have.
